Current status of Croatian scientific journals

420 journals in OA available in Hrčak (13 more than in 2023)

166 journals in **DOAJ** (5 more than in 2023)

203 journals in SJR (45 more than in 2023)

122 journals in JCR (2 suspended from 2023)

Funding

- Funding agreements with higher education institutions and public research institutes
- Funding call for learned societies by the Ministry of Science, Education and Youth 882.071 EUR in 2024 for 132 learned societies (for all activities)
- APCs (60-800 EUR for 13 journals in DOAJ)
- Subscriptions for printed copies
- Some journals have several co-publishers and funding streams
- > No public information about journal funding
- ➤ No quality assessment from the funding bodies

Membership

- 14 members of the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE)
- 67 individual members of the European Association of Science Editors (EASE) via CROASC
- 142 members of the Croatian Association for Scholarly Communication

Croatian Association for Scholarly Communication (CROASC or ZNAK in Croatian)

Established in September 2019 - association of 50 journal editors, researchers and librarians

Today: 109 individual members and 33 institutions (faculties, universities, learned societies, journals)

Main goals:

- Promoting transparent, publicly funded and OA scholarly communication
- •Increasing the quality of scholarly output
- Helping journal editors and publishers in their work
- ■Cooperation with other stakeholders (Ministry, National and University Library in Zagreb, University and Computing Centre SRCE, EASE, Elsevier, Clarivate, JISC, DOAJ, OPERAS consortium etc.)

- Raising the visibility of Croatian journals (indexing databases, promotion, networking)
- Establishing Croatian Diamond Capacity Centre to provide infrastructure, training, resources, tools and support for publishers in diamond OA
- Collaboration with other institutions, organisations, associations, and diamond capacity centres (Slovenia, Serbia, and others)
