 - Data provider for OpenAIRE since 2015
 - OpenAIRE v4 compliant







Hrčak - supporting good publishing practices

- · Criteria for inclusion
- Identifiers DOI, ORCID
- OJS
 - upgraded to version 3.4.0-9 in August 2025
 - upgraded synchronisation with HRČAK
- OMP
- Machine-readability
 - Automated conversion to JATS XML for HRČAK users
 - JATS XML Converter Service
- · Workshops, guidelines







- unique and persistent identifier of researchers and contributors
- increases author's visibility and interoperability between a wide range of information services
- a valid email address stored in HRČAK (mandatory!)
- an author receives an email from HRČAK which guides them through the process of linking their paper in HRČAK with his/her ORCID profile
- the system automatically sends a request to connect to the ORCID profile every Tuesday and Thursday at 9 am







Publishers and editors

- 490+ publishers
- 1100+ journal administrators

Journals and content

- 88 active journals in HRČAK OJS (out of 100+ included)
- 420 active journals on HRČAK (out of 559 total)
- 24.000+ issues
- 310.000+ full-text articles

JATS XML

- 1400+ articles in XML (auto-converted)
- 5000+ manually prepared XML articles
- 100+ users of JATS XML Converter Service

• 96.600+ ORCID identifiers

Ensuring journal quality in HRČAK

- Established in 2017 by the HRČAK Advisory Board
- Latest version (2.1) adopted in 2023

9 mandatory criteria

- Open Access
- Connection to the Republic of Croatia
- First publication
- Editorial board for multiple institutions
- Author guidelines
- Peer review policy
- Article categorisation
- Article metadata
- Masthead





Activity statuses in HRČAK

Activity statuses

- Active if less than 13 months have passed since the publication of the last complete issue or at least one "online first" paper has been published in the last 6 months
- Inactive if more than 13 months have passed since the last issue was published. Despite this status, the editorial boards can still edit their journals and publish papers
- No longer publishing on HRČAK the editorial board has delivered the information that the journal has stopped publishing on HRČAK or more than 26 months have passed since the last issue was published
- · No longer publishing the editorial board has delivered the information that the journal is no longer being published
- New journal
- Suspended
- Automatic activity verification four times a year
 - 1 March; 1 June; 1 September; 1 December
- Regular publishing is <u>important!</u>
 - · Late publishing leads to delayed or missed indexing in other databases





Pre-evaluation of journals for Scopus

- Collaboration Croatian Association for Scholarly Communication (CROASC/ZNAK), National and University Library in Zagreb (NSK) and SRCE
- December 2023
- Technical aspects of editorial quality
 - Title and abstract in english
 - Peer-review
 - Publication ethics and malpractice statement
 - Regular publishing
- Joint application of 108 journals
- Challenges
 - Time-consuming task
 - Extensive back-and-forth communication with editors





Future evaluation and certification of journals

- Start in October 2025
- Goal is to provide a comprehensive assessment of journal quality without evaluating content
- Motives
 - Enhance editorial quality of journals
 - Enhance visibility of (diamond, Croatian) OA journals
 - Improve metadata
 - Educate editorial boards about the improvement of editorial policies according to the latest trends in scientific publishing
 - Serve as a stepping stone for entry into other databases
- Focus on Diamond Open Access
- Current context in European systems (HRČAK, DOAS, DDH)
- · Considering expansion of HRČAK criteria and interface updates to enhance metadata input

Evaluation and certification of journals Methodology

- 1. Review of existing criteria (HRČAK, DOAS, DDH)
- 2. Defining certification seals
 - · Required vs desired criteria
- 3. Improvement of interface and metadata with the purpose of maximal automatisation of evaluation
- 4. Drafting guidelines and instructions
- 5. Communication with editors and publishers about upcoming changes and expectations
